Course Description

A liability claim for bodily injury or death against a municipality creates unique challenges in reporting, limitation periods, and proving negligence of a municipality and its employees.

Topics discussed support learners understanding of the fundamental principles and structure of the Municipal Government Act (Alberta) with respect to liability claims, claims reporting and settlement. Learners explore and discuss common types of liability claims that arise from municipal operations.

Learners identify and describe common categories of information required in a typical municipal notice of claim and discover helpful hints to share with clients in preparing to submit a liability claim.

Learning is applied through the completion of an exercise using a Claim Scenario.
